GEOHAZARD THREAT ADVISORY

Latest update from Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) of the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) states that the center of Tropical Depression "LANNIE" was estimated based on all available data at 110 km East of Surigao City, Surigao del Norte (9.7°N, 123.5°E) with a maximum sustained winds of 45km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 55 km/h. It is moving northwestward at 20 km/h.

The tropical depression is rain-inducing and may bring heavy rainfall that may trigger landslides and flooding in your area. Hence, heavy rains brought by TD Lannie may trigger landslide particularly in areas classified as having **Moderate to High Susceptibility to Landslide** as well as possible **flashfloods in areas along natural waterways (rivers/creeks/gullies/abandoned or active) and coastal areas.**

In view of this, please be advised to take the necessary precautions. Likewise, you are further advised to undertake pre-emptive measures especially at times of incessant rainfall. All residents in the highlands, at or near the foot of steep slopes, in the lowlands, in the coastal zones, or perceived at risk, should adhere to LGU's evacuation and relocation protocols.

Your vigilance and pro-active action is highly encouraged during this time.
